Social Media "Connectivity" and Biblical Relationship

Most people in the United States *think* we are a relational culture. There are hundreds of books published on this very subject each year. We have tiny supercomputers (i.e., cell phones) in our pockets with countless faces and numbers saved. Why is it, then, that we can't seem to find the time to follow up and follow through with them?

It is true that we are connected digitally. We stay busy "liking" and "subscribing," and yet we feel less connected in the end. Something is missing.

The truth is that relational connection with others takes consistent intention, time, and energy. It requires commitment, selflessness, and sacrifice. This is a higher price than most people are willing to pay. Relationship requires work.

Biblical friendship, compared to digital connectivity, is *countercultural*. Those of us who hunger for true, life-on-life connection—the kind that Jesus calls us to live out–find that we are daily pushing *against* and *through* a social environment that doesn't value the requisite work of friendship. Because of Jesus, Christians make a conscious choice to do the countercultural thing and work for love and deep connection with one another. This makes us different. "By this all will know that you are My disciples," Jesus said in John 13:34, "if you have love for one another."

The Bible calls the church a *family.* "The church isn't the building, it's the people." Family is about relationship, from beginning to end. We can't function as "a people" without relationship. We depend on one another. We serve each other. We do life together (see 1 Corinthians 12:12-30).

At the same time, many of us feel time and energy poor. The weeks are long, overbooked, and scattered. Our energy is used up by the seemingly endless tasks that need our attention, and often the work of relationship just feels like more items to add to our bottomless to-do list. When life is already overwhelming, how do we make space for the most important parts of life—people? And what's more, how do we find it in us—those of us with a belief that relationship is *real* life—to be the ones reaching out, checking in, trying to get together, leaving messages, and initiating time and time again?

Where do we find the energy to push against these challenges and intentionally counter our culture? We need a power greater than ourselves.

Another popular phrase is "you can't pour from an empty cup." But we that serve in the church know this isn't true. Your cup is filled even as you empty it by the Holy Spirit who values this effort as the work of building the kingdom. When you relationally create space by reaching out to others, you draw people together, and commit to them in a way that pushes back the darkness and invites all participants deeper into the family of God.

In a culture starved for authentic friendship and drowning in empty social connection, being relational isn't easy. But it is of incredible, eternal value. So, we press on!

This week as you pray for the people of Shadow Mountain, take this issue before our heavenly Father. It
